**Subject : Proposal for a Council Regulation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office {COM(2013) 534 final}**

The Commission has received, within the deadline laid down by Article 6 of Protocol No 2 to the Treaty on European Union and the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union on the application of the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality, reasoned opinions from 14 chambers of national Parliaments in relation to the above-mentioned proposal.<sup>1</sup>

The reasoned opinions received represent 18 of the 56 votes allocated to national Parliaments in accordance with Protocol No 2. The threshold specified in Article 7.2 of Protocol No 2 has thus been reached.

The Commission will now proceed, in accordance with the above-mentioned article, to review the legislative proposal in question so as to decide whether to maintain, amend or withdraw it.
