RESOLUTION ON THE EU FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS AGENCY

Participants of the Birštonas meeting proposed not to discuss the necessity of establishing the EU Fundamental Rights Agency, because the countries accept in general the idea of its creation. In the opinion of the majority, there is an urgent need to discuss the scope of competence of the Agency and its cooperation with international organisations, especially with the Council of Europe, with a view of avoiding duplication of functions.
