

18th sitting of the Sejm, 11–13 JULY 2012

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on environment protection and some related acts;
- amending the act on population records and identification documents and some related acts;
- amending the Code of Penal Procedure and some related acts;
- amending the act on departments of government administration and some related acts (print no. 215);
- amending the act on departments of government administration and some related acts (print no. 375);
- amending the act on animal feed;
- ratifying the Protocol between the Government of the Republic of Poland and the Government of the Republic of Cyprus amending the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Poland and the Government of the Republic of Cyprus for the avoidance of double taxation with respect to taxes on income and on capital, drawn up in Warsaw on 4 July 1992, signed in Nicosia on 22 March 2012.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning the election of the Constitutional Tribunal's judge;
- honouring the 90th anniversary of the return of Upper Silesia to the Polish State.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the Code of Penal Procedure (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on preventing and combating infections and contagious human diseases and the act on the State Sanitary Inspection (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on the State Sanitary Inspection and some related acts.

THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- report presented by the Minister of Treasury on the activity of the State Treasury Solicitor's Office in the period 1 January 2011 – 31 December 2011;
- report on the activities of the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection in 2011.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION on the construction of LNG liquefied natural gas terminal in relation to the insolvency of the construction works contractor.

Elżbieta Achinger took the Deputies' oath.

THE SEJM HONoured with a moment of silence the memory of victims massacred in Volhynia and Eastern Little Poland in the summer of 1943.
