

## 20<sup>th</sup> sitting of the Sejm, 29–30 August 2012

**THE SEJM RETURNED TO THE COMMITTEE** the Government bill amending the act on family benefits.

**THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES** the Government bill amending the Telecommunications Law and some related acts.

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the Code of Penal Procedure and some related acts (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Code of Penal Procedure (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Customs Law (*the Senate's amendment was accepted*);
- amending the act on preparation for the European Football Championship UEFA EURO 2012 Final Tournament (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);



■ amending the act on Maritime Code and the act on maritime areas of the Republic of Poland and on maritime administration (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);

■ on the State Commission for the Investigation of Marine Accidents (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*).

### THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- information of the Prime Minister and the Prosecutor General on the operations of the state institutions as regards the Amber Gold Ltd.;
- Government information on the realisation of tasks related to the distribution of social aid by the schools and on the social function of the school.

**THE SEJM WAS PRESENTED WITH** the information on the activity of the National Council of the Judiciary in 2011.

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED** the current information on the activities undertaken by the Government, aimed at levelling direct farming subsidies considered discriminatory towards the Polish agriculture, simplifying the Common Agricultural Policy and directing the funds to competitiveness and progress.

### THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- honouring all the victims murdered and persecuted in the Soviet Union within the so-called Polish Operation in the years 1937–1938;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees;
- concerning the election of the new personal composition of the European Union Affairs Committee.

**THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING** the Deputies' draft resolution concerning the appointment of an investigative committee for examining the correctness of operations or reasons for neglect of the part of the organs of the government administration and the Prosecution Service as regards conducting the activity by the Amber Gold Ltd. and its subordinate entities.

## 21<sup>th</sup> sitting of the Sejm, 11–14 September 2012

### THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on family benefits;
- amending the act on consumer credit and the act on the liability on the part of collective entities for the acts prohibited under penalty;
- amending the act on supporting the development of the telecommunications services and networks and some related acts;
- on the duties related to providing information on the energy consumption by the energy-using products;
- amending the Public Procurement Law and the act on the concession for construction works or services;
- amending the act on the veterinary border control and the Postal Law;
- ratifying the Treaty between the Kingdom of Belgium, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, the Kingdom of Denmark, the Federal Republic of Germany, the Republic of Estonia, Ireland, the Hellenic Republic, the Kingdom of Spain, the French Republic, the Italian Republic, the Republic of Cyprus, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, the Republic of Hungary, the Republic of Malta, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the Republic of Austria, the Republic of Poland, the Portuguese Republic, Romania, the Republic of Slovenia, the Slovak Republic, the Republic of Finland, the Kingdom of Sweden, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (Member States of the European Union) and the Republic of Croatia concerning the accession of the Republic of Croatia to the European Union, drawn up in Brussels on 9 December 2011.

### THE SEJM PASSED THE RESOLUTIONS

- concerning granting the permission by the Sejm of the Republic of Poland to bring Deputy Stanisław Pięta to criminal accountability;
- concerning grant the permission by the Sejm of the Republic of Poland to bring Deputy Piotr Chmielowski to civil accountability.

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the Law on Assemblies (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Press Law (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*).

**THE SEJM RETURNED TO THE COMMITTEE** the Government bill amending the act on energy efficiency.

### THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure;
- Senate's bill amending the act – Introductory provisions to the Electoral Code;

- Government bill annulling the decree on territories of particular importance for the defence of the State and amending the Maritime Code.

### THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

- the Deputies' bill on the liquidation of the Institute of National Remembrance – Commission for the Prosecution of Crimes against the Polish Nation;
- Deputies' bill on the Fiscal Council;
- Deputies' bill amending the Geological and Mining Law and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on political parties and the act on the personal income tax.

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on public fundraising and some related acts (*Motions to reject both bills shall be considered at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

### THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE SECOND READING

the Deputies' draft resolution concerning the procedure for granting the permission to ratify the Treaty between the Kingdom of Belgium, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, the Kingdom of Denmark, the Federal Republic of Germany, the Republic of Estonia, Ireland, the Hellenic Republic, the Kingdom of Spain, the French Republic, the Italian Republic, the Republic of Cyprus, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, the Republic of Hungary, the Republic of Malta, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the Republic of Austria, the Republic of Poland, the Portuguese Republic, Romania, the Republic of Slovenia, the Slovak Republic, the Republic of Finland, the Kingdom of Sweden, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (Member States of the European Union) and the Republic of Croatia concerning the accession of the Republic of Croatia to the European Union, drawn up in Brussels on 9 December 2011.

### THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- reports of the President of the Institute of National Remembrance on the activity of the Institute of National Remembrance – Commission for the Prosecution of Crimes against the Polish Nation in the periods: 1 January 2009 – 31 December 2009, 1 January 2010 – 31 December 2010, 1 January 2011 – 31 December 2011;
- information of the Minister of the Interior and the Minister of Justice on the establishment of the Common European Asylum System (CEAS).

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED** the current information on the financial crisis in the units of the local government.
