

31st sitting of the Sejm, 3-4 JANUARY 2013

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on retirement pay and social benefits financed out of Social Insurance Fund;
- amending the act on upbringing in sobriety and prevention of alcoholism;
- amending the act on vehicle drivers’;
- ratifying the Agreement between the Republic of Poland and Grenada for the Exchange of Information Relating to Tax Matters, signed in New York on 19 July 2012.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- on considering the proposal for a directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on improving the gender balance among non-executive directors of companies listed on stock exchanges and related measures inconsistent with the principle of subsidiarity;
- concerning the 150th anniversary of the January Uprising.

THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies’ bill amending the act on spatial planning and order;
- Government bill amending the act on crop protection chemicals;
- Senate’s bill amending the act on cleanliness and order maintenance within communes and the act amending the act on cleanliness and order maintenance within communes and some related acts.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill amending the act on payment due dates in commerce transactions;

- Deputies’ bill – Cooperative Law (of the print no. 980);
- Deputies’ bill – Cooperative Law (of the print no. 1005);
- Deputies’ bill amending the Code of Civil Procedure.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE’S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the act on particular principles for preparation and realisation of investments in the area of public roads (*The Senate’s amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Water Law and some related acts (*The Senate’s amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies’ bill on cooperatives;
- Deputies’ bill amending the act on housing cooperatives;
- Deputies’ bill on housing cooperatives;
- Deputies’ bill on the activity of housing cooperatives; (*Marshall of the Sejm postponed the votes on the motions to reject the bills to the next sitting.*)

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION on the situation in the Fiat Auto Poland SA factory in Tychy as regards the group layoffs and the condition of the automotive branch in Poland.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE SECOND READING the Deputies’ draft resolution concerning appointing a High Citizen Commission to explain the causes of the Tu-154M plane crash.
