

33rd sitting of the Sejm, 6-8 FEBRUARY 2013

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- on payment due dates in commerce transactions;
- amending the Code of Penal Procedure;
- on the revised scope of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, drawn up in Washington on 3 March 1973.

THE SEJM ADOPTED THE RESOLUTION amending the resolution concerning the appointment and election of a personal composition of the Special Committee to examine particular bills regarding the Cooperative Law.

THE SEJM RETURNED TO THE COMMITTEE the Deputies' bill amending the act on corporate savings and loan associations, as well as amending some related acts.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill amending the act on the Bank Guarantee Fund and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Civil Code;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on the financial market supervision and some related acts.

THE SEJM ACCEPTED the information submitted by the Prime Minister on the European Commission withholding 4 billion euro of the EU funds for road construction projects supervised by the General Directorate for National Roads and Motorways within the programmes "Infrastructure and Environment" and "Eastern Poland Development", as well as on the possibility of losing EU funds for the railway construction and on the lack of supervision over the

General Directorate for National Roads and Motorways.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED the information of the Government of the Republic of Poland on the activities undertaken in 2011 as to realise the provisions of the resolution of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland of 1 August 1997 "The Charter of the Disabled Persons' Rights" (*The motion to reject the information shall be considered at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION on the assessment of efficiency of activities undertaken by the Government so as to decrease unemployment and improve the financial situation of families (particularly of unemployed persons with children) in the conditions of a dynamic growth of the unemployment rate in 2012 and disadvantageous forecasts as regards the increase of the employment rate and citizens' income in 2013.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies' bill amending the Labour Code;
- Deputies' bill amending the Labour Code and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on the goods and services tax;
- Deputies' bill amending the Electoral code.

THE SEJM DID NOT ACCEPT the Deputies' motion to recall Deputy Wanda Nowicka from the function of the Vice-Marshall of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING the Deputies' draft resolution amending the resolution establishing the number of Vice-Marshals of the Sejm.
