

34th sitting of the Sejm, 19–22 FEBRUARY 2013

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- Treaty on Stability, Coordination and Governance in the Economic and Monetary Union between the Kingdom of Belgium, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Kingdom of Denmark, the Federal Republic of Germany, the Republic of Estonia, Ireland, the Hellenic Republic, the Kingdom of Spain, the French Republic, the Italian Republic, the Republic of Cyprus, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the Republic of Austria, the Republic of Poland, the Portuguese Republic, Romania, the Republic of Slovenia, the Slovak Republic, the Republic of Finland, and the Kingdom of Sweden, drawn up in Brussels on 2 March 2012;
- amending the act on social aid and some related acts;
- amending the act on road transport and the act on the act on drivers' working time;
- amending the act on reconstruction, technical modernisation and financing of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Poland.

THE SEJM ADOPTED THE RESOLUTION concerning granting the permission by the Sejm of the Republic of Poland to bring to criminal accountability Deputy Stefan Niesiołowski (*In the resolution, the Sejm did not grant the permission to bring the Deputy to criminal accountability*).

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code;
- Government bill amending the act on reimbursement of the excise duty included in the price of the diesel oil used in the agricultural production.

THE SEJM RETURNED TO THE COMMITTEE

the Deputies' bill amending the act on commercialisation, restructurisation and privatisation of the public company "Polskie Koleje Państwowe" (Polish National Railways) and the act on the Railway Fund.

THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- information of the Prime Minister on the results of negotiations concerning the multiannual financial framework for 2014–2020;
- information submitted by the Minister of Environment on the realisation of the long-term "Świnna Poreba water reservoir construction programme for 2006–2013" in 2011;
- information submitted by the Council of Ministers on the realisation of tasks resulting from the "Programme for the Oder – 2006" in 2011;
- information submitted by the Council of Minister on the state of forests and the realisation of the National Forestation Programme in 2011.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED INFORMATION of the Minister relevant for education and upbringing on the state of preparations of governing authorities to subject six-year-old children to schooling duty (*The motion to reject the information shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION on the planned reorganisation of the units of the Border Guard.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

the Deputies' bill amending the Commercial Companies Code.
