

## 41<sup>st</sup> sitting of the Sejm, 22–24 MAY 2013

### THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on excise duty;
- amending the act on land and mortgage register and mortgage (of print no. 1027);
- amending the act on land and mortgage register and mortgage (of print no. 1218);
- amending the act on execution of penalty of detention in the form of electronic monitoring beyond the limits of a penal institution;
- amending the act on toll motorways and the National Road Fund, and the act on public roads;
- amending the act on rail transport and the act which itself amended the act on the rail transport;
- amending the act on refunding medicinal drugs, foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional use and medicinal products;
- ratifying the Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Principality of Andorra for the Exchange of Information Relating to Tax Matters, signed in Andorra la Vella on 15 June 2012.

### THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- honouring the memory of Grzegorz Przemyski – the victim of the martial law, on the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of His death;
- establishing 4 June the Day of Freedom and Civic Rights;
- concerning granting the permission by the Sejm of the Republic of Poland to bring Deputy Zbigniew Babalski to criminal accountability (*The Sejm did not grant the permission to bring Deputy Zbigniew Babalski to criminal accountability*);
- amending the resolution concerning the appointment and election of the personal composition of the Special Committee to consider particular acts concerning the cooperative law;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- on the means of physical coercion and firearms (*Some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on vehicle drivers and some related acts (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Banking Law and the act on investment funds (*The Senate's amendments were not accepted*);
- amending the act on medical chambers and some related acts (*The Senate's amendments were not accepted*).

### THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Senate's bill amending the Tax Ordinance, the Fiscal Penal Code and the Customs Law;
- Deputies' bill amending the Labour Code;
- Deputies' bill amending the Code of Civil Procedure (of print no. 1323).

**THE SEJM ACCEPTED** the information of the Council of Ministers on the realisation of the Government programme of preferential housing credits "Rodzina na swoim" ["Family in a place of their own"] and the intention of introducing past 31 December 2013 of support systems for fulfilment of families' housing needs.

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION** on mass dismissal of employees forecasted by companies (*The motion to reject the information shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION** considering the Government "Programme for infertility treatment via in vitro fertilisation in the years 2013–2016".

### THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies' bill on the National Employment Programme;
- Deputies' bill amending the Code of Civil Procedure (of print no. 1269).

### THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the Labour Code and some related acts.

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION** on the functioning of the public health care, particularly the plans of the Ministry of Health to reduce the package of guaranteed services and to introduce additional health insurance.
