

## 60<sup>th</sup> SITTING OF THE SEJM, 5–7 FEBRUARY 2014

### THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending Public Procurement Law and some related acts;
- amending the act on the goods and services tax and some related acts;
- amending the Code of Civil Procedure;
- amending the Road Traffic Act and some related acts;
- amending the act on the Christian Theological Academy in Warsaw;
- ratifying the Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Republic of Liberia for the Exchange of Information Related to Tax Matters, signed in New York on 7 August 2013;
- ratifying the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Poland and the Government of Malaysia for the Avoidance of Double Taxation the Prevention of Fiscal Evasion with Respect to Taxes on Income and the Protocol thereto, signed in Kuala Lumpur of 8 July 2013.

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- on participation of foreign officials or employees in joint operations or joint rescue missions on the territory of the Republic of Poland (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Code of Civil Procedure (*The Senate's amendment was accepted*).

### THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill on consumer's rights;
- Government bill on informing about prices of goods and services;
- Government bill on lost-and-found items and amending some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code.

### THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies' bill amending the act on the goods and services tax;

- Deputies' bill amending the act on the excise duty.

**THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE THIRD READING** the Deputies' draft resolution amending the Standing Orders of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland.

### THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- document submitted by the Prime Minister "Information of the Council of Ministers on realization in 2012 of the Act of 9 June 2011 on supporting the family and the system of foster care" (*The motion to reject the information, submitted at the 59<sup>th</sup> sitting, was not accepted*);
- information of the Council of Ministers on realization of tasks resulting from the National Drug Use Prevention Programme in 2011 and 2012;
- Government document "Report on the realization of tasks resulting from the Act of 6 November 2008 on patient's rights and the Commissioner for Patient's Rights and respecting patient's rights on the territory of the Republic of Poland";
- Government document "Report on respecting patient's rights on the territory of the Republic of Poland in the period between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2012".

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION** on the State Forests National Forest Holding.

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION** for the Sejm and the Senate on participation of the Republic of Poland in the works of the European Union in the period between July and December 2013 (Lithuanian Presidency of the Council of the European Union) and the draft resolution presented by the European Union Affairs Committee (*As amendments were submitted during the second reading, the draft resolution was returned to the Committee*).
