

64th SITTING OF THE SEJM, 19–21 MARCH 2014

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on health care benefits provided out of public funds and some related acts;
- amending the act on commercialisation and privatisation;
- amending the act on the system of education and the Aliens Act;
- amending the act on railway transport, the act on commercialisation, restructurisation and privatisation of the public company Polish National Railways and the act on the Railway Fund;
- amending the act on maritime safety.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- honouring the memory of Jacek Kuroń;
- concerning additional election of the composition of the Tribunal of State (*The Sejm of the Republic of Poland elected Lech Morawski to the Tribunal of State*);
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ACT

amending the act on biocomponents and liquid biofuels as well as amending some related acts (*Some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bill amending the act on waste;
- President of the Republic's bill amending the Water Law and some related acts.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bills: amending the Family and Guardianship Code, amending the Family and Guardianship Code and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Labour Code;
- Deputies' bill amending the Code of Civil Procedure;
- Deputies' bill amending particular acts related to real estate property ownership transformations;
- Senate's bill on petitions;
- Deputies' and Government's bills amending the act on the Police and some related acts (*The Sejm did not accept the motions to reject the bills submitted at the 63rd sitting*).

THE SEJM REJECTED

- Deputies' bill amending the Labour Code;
- Citizens' bill "SUNDAY OFF" amending the Labour Code;
- Deputies' bill amending the goods and services tax.

THE SEJM ACCEPTED the report on the state of forests and implementation of the National Forestation Programme in 2012, submitted by the Council of Ministers.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION

on the future of aviation market in Poland, particularly of state-owned entities or entities with state shareholding: "Polish Airports" State Enterprise, Polish Airlines LOT JSC, EuroLot JSC and companies, in which Polish Airlines LOT JSC had their shares or stock.
