

68th SITTING OF THE SEJM, 28–30 MAY 2014

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on the system of education and some related acts;
- amending the act on the protection of employees' claims in case of insolvency of the employer;
- on reimbursement of particular unpaid entrepreneur dues, resulting from the realisation of commissioned public procurement;
- amending the Energy Law;
- amending the act on railway transport;
- amending the Attorneys Act and some related acts.

THE SEJM ADOPTED THE RESOLUTION concerning the election of the new personal composition of the European Union Affairs Committee.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- on consumer's rights (some of the Senate's amendments were accepted);
- amending the Water Law and some related acts (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on stocks of crude oil, petroleum products and natural gas, the principles of proceeding in circumstances of a threat to the fuel security of the State and disruption on the petroleum market and some related acts (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on investments related to the regasification terminal of liquefied natural gas in Świnoujście and the act on real estate management (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on national and ethnic minorities and on the regional language, as well as the act on departments of government administration (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on competition and consumer protection and the Code of Civil Procedure (*the Senate's amendments shall be voted at the next sitting of the Sejm*);
- amending the act on quartering of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Poland (*the Senate's amendments shall be considered at the next sitting of the Sejm*);
- amending the act on plant protection (*the Senate's amendments shall be considered at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bill amending the Electoral Code and some related acts (*print no. 1786*);
- Government bill amending the Geodetic and Cartographic Law (*the Sejm did not accept the motion to*

reject in the bill in the first reading, submitted at the 67th sitting; the bill was returned to the Committee after the second reading had been held).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE SECOND READING

- Government bill amending the Accountancy Act;
- Government bill amending the act on principles of use or presence of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Poland beyond the borders of the state (*the Sejm decided to hold a vote on rejecting the bill as a whole, without acquiring a Committee opinion, at the next sitting*);
- Senate's and Deputies' bills amending the act on the Supreme Court;
- President of the Republic's bill amending the act on the Supreme Court (*the Sejm decided to hold a vote on a motion to reject the bill as a whole, without acquiring a Committee opinion, at the next sitting*).

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bill amending the act on freedom of business activity and some related acts (*the Sejm did not accept the motion to reject the bill in the first reading, submitted at the 67th sitting*);
- President of the Republic's bill amending the Law on the system of common courts and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Electoral Code and some related acts (*print no. 2337*);
- Deputies' bill amending the Electoral Code (*print no. 2338*);
- Senate's bill amending the Penal Code and the Penal Execution Code;
- Committee bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure;
- Senate's bill amending the act which itself amended the Code of Penal Procedure and some related acts;
- Senate's bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies' bill amending the Constitution of the Republic of Poland (*the motion to refer the bill to a specifically appointed special committee shall be considered at the next sitting*);
- Citizens' bill amending the act on animal protection (*the motion to reject the bill shall be considered at the next sitting*);
- Deputies' draft resolution appointing the Investigative Committee to examine the correctness of actions of the organs of government administration as regards tenders organized in accordance with

the procedure of public procurement in the years 2007–2010 for the purchase of IT equipment and services by the IT Project and Services Centre of the former Ministry of Interior and Administration and the Police Headquarters, as regards tenders in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 2011 for attendance to the Polish Presidency in the European Union, and as regards tenders for realization of IT project for the Central Statistical Office of Poland in 2011 and the Voivodeship Emergency Notification Centre in Warsaw (the motion to reject the draft resolution shall be considered at the next sitting);

- Deputies' draft resolution appointing the Investigative Committee to examine anomalies as regards public procurement for the purchase of IT equipment and services by the IT Projects Centre of the

former Ministry of Interior and Administration and the Police Headquarters in 2007–2010 for the sum of over PLN 2 000 000 000 and as regards public procurement for the attendance to the Polish Presidency in the European Union for the sum of PLN 34 000 000, realization of IT projects for the Central Statistical Office of Poland for the sum of PLN 6 000 000 and for the Voivodeship Emergency Notification Centre in Warsaw for the sum of PLN 24 000 000, as well as public procurement realized by CAM Media S.A. with its seat in Warsaw (the motion to reject the draft resolution shall be considered at the next sitting).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED INFORMATION on situation in the black coal mining industry.
