CEREMONIAL MEETING OF DEPUTIES AND SENATORS, 17 DECEMBER 2014

Poles reached out their brotherly hand, when the enemy invaded our home. Ukrainians shall never forget your help – said the President of Ukraine, Petro Poroshenko, at the ceremonial meeting of Deputies and Senators held in the Sejm. The special announcement by the Ukrainian President was also heard by i.a. the President of the Republic of Poland, members of the Government and the diplomatic corps.

As the President of Ukraine reminded, Ukraine regained its independence peacefully in 1991, but today pays a high price for both being independent and for its European identity – the price of human life. A year ago Ukrainians proved to be worth their ancestors and their history. They proved to be a European nation – he emphasized. He also thanked for the Polish presence at the Maidan and the help, including humanitarian aid, which Ukraine receives.

Ukrainian President also talked about the persistent support of the Polish President, the Sejm, the Senate and the Government for Ukraine's European aspirations. During the Polish Presidency of the European Union we were able to finalize our negotiations and thus to prepare a historic agreement, the Ukraine-European Union Association Agreement – he reminded.

According to President Poroshenko, the conflict presently taking place in the east of Ukraine is in fact a war. As he said, Ukraine is not only standing up for its sovereignty and territorial integrity. *Today, at our eastern borders, at the borders of our country, we are defending Europe, European affairs, and the democracy* – the pointed.

At the forum of the Polish Parliament, Petro Poroshenko also announced abandoning Ukraine's non-aligned status proclaimed in 2010, as it did not guarantee the country the security and territorial integrity.

The President also pointed that Ukraine is already now intensifying its cooperation with the NATO. In his announcement, Petro Poroshenko assured that Ukraine is aware of the necessity to conduct reforms so as to bring the country closer to Europe.
