

84TH SITTING OF THE SEJM, 13–16 JANUARY 2015

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on the functioning of the coal mining industry in the years 2008–2015 and some related acts;
- on renewable energy sources;
- amending the Construction Law and some related acts;
- amending the Penal Code and some related acts;
- amending the Law on the system of common courts and some related acts;
- amending the act on the personal income tax and the Tax Ordinance;
- amending the act on road transport and some related acts;
- amending the act on the system of education and some related acts;
- on transforming one-person companies of the State Treasury conducting activity using cultural property into state cultural institutions;
- on found property;
- amending the act establishing the long-term programme “Construction of the Campus of the 600th anniversary of the Jagiellonian University Revival.”

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning granting the consent to bring Deputy Andrzej Piątak to criminal accountability for the deed specified in the motion of the Chief Commander of the Police of 31 October 2014 (*the Sejm granted its consent*);
- concerning the election of the new personal composition of the European Union Affairs’ Committee;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE’S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- Budget Act for 2015;
- on bonds;
- amending the act on the Customs Service, the act on fiscal offices and chambers and some related acts;
- amending the Code of Civil Procedure and some related acts;
- amending the act on genetically modified organisms and some related acts;
- amending the act on principles for financing science and some related acts;
- on protection of animals used for scientific or educational purposes;
- amending the act on railway transport and some related acts;
- amending the act on waste and some related acts;
- amending the act on biocomponents and liquid biofuels and some related acts.

THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEE the Government bill amending the act on the national archive resources and archives.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- President of the Republic’s bill amending the Tax Ordinance and some related acts;
- President of the Republic’s bill amending the Law on associations and some related acts;
- Government bill amending the act on recycling end-of-life vehicles and some related acts;
- Deputies’ bill amending the Hunting law and some related acts.

THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- Report on the realization of the act of 4 February 2011 on custody over children below three years of age in the years 2011–2012 and in 2013;
- Report of the Minister relevant for education and upbringing on the state of preparations of governing authorities to subject six-year-old children to schooling duty;
- Report of the Minister of Labour and Social Policy on realisation of a long-term programme “State food aid” in the period between January 2010 and December 2013.

THE SEJM HEARD report of the Council of Ministers on the realisation the National Domestic Violence Counteraction Programme between 1 January 2013 and 31 December 2013 (*the motion to reject the report shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION concerning the situation in the coal mining industry.
