

90TH SITTING OF THE SEJM, 8–9 APRIL 2015

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- Restructuring Law;
- amending the act on the system of social insurance;
- amending the act on the personal income tax and some related act;
- amending the act on the income of the units of territorial government;
- amending the Pharmaceutical Law and some related acts;
- amending the act on public statistics and some related acts;
- amending the Petty Offences Procedure Code;
- amending the act on the safety of persons within water areas;
- ratifying the Council Decision of 26 May 2014 on the system of own resources of the European Union (2014/335/UE, Euratom);
- ratifying the Protocol no. 15 amending the Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms, drawn up in Strasbourg on 24 June 2013.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

- Government bill on infertility treatment;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on acquiring, storing and transplanting cells, tissues and organs;
- Government bill on the used electric and electronic appliances;
- Senate's bill amending the act on the profession of a veterinary physician and on the chambers of veterinary physicians, and some related acts.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies' bill on the protection of the human genome and human embryo, and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill on the planned parenthood.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the act on judicial enforcement officers and enforcement (*the Senate's amendment was accepted*);
- amending the Law on proceedings before administrative courts (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);

- amending the act on the National School of the Judiciary and Public Prosecution (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on the goods and services tax and the Public Procurement Law (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Road Traffic Law (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION concerning the security of resources accumulated in the corporate savings and loan associations.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning granting the consent of the Sejm to bring Deputy Piotr Babinetz to civil accountability (*the Sejm did not grant its consent to bring Deputy to accountability*);
- concerning granting the consent of the Sejm to bring Deputy Kazimierz Moskal to civil accountability (*the Sejm did not grant its consent to bring Deputy to accountability*);
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

THE SEJM ELECTED

- **Edyta Bielak-Jomaa** for the position of the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection (*for the candidature, submitted by Civic Platform club, there voted 236 Deputies; absolute majority required equalled 214 votes; for the candidature of Sylwester Marcin Królak, submitted by the Democratic Left Alliances and unaffiliated Deputies, there voted 39 Deputies; 152 Deputies crossed out all the candidatures*);
- Deputy **Eugeniusz Grzeszczak** for the position of a member of the National Prosecution Council (*for his candidature there voted 405 Deputies, 5 were against, 2 withheld their votes; the absolute majority required equalled 207 votes*).

Halina Olendzka took the Deputies' oath.
