RESOLUTION

of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland

of 8 May 2003

on the implementation by the Council of Ministers of the provisions of Poland's

Accession Treaty to the European Union concerning financing direct payments

from the state budget in 2004-2006

§ 1.

In order to create the conditions and guarantees for implementing the provisions of

Poland's Accession Treaty to the European Union, the Sejm of the Republic of

Poland urges the Council of Ministers to secure funding for direct payments for

eligible farmers in draft 2004-2006 budgets, which - together with funds from the

European Union – will guarantee payments:

- in the amount of 55% in 2004.

- in the amount of 60% in 2005.

- in the amount of 65% in 2006.

§ 2.

The Council of Ministers should inscribe the earmarked amount referred to in § 1 as a

separate budget item in the "Agriculture" section of the budget bill.

§ 3.

The Resolution enters into force on the day it is passed.
