

RESOLUTION
of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland
of 15 June 2007
on negotiations on the new Treaty of the European Union

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland believes that the new Treaty of the European Union should be a compromise that would strengthen the Union and streamline its operations, and at the same time ensure Poland's strong position, corresponding to the Polish potential.

Therefore, the Sejm of the Republic of Poland calls on the Government of the Republic of Poland to take effective measures to include in the negotiation mandate of the Intergovernmental Conference the issue of weighting votes in the Council of the European Union.

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland is in favour of accepting the so-called square root system of weighting individual Member States' votes as the appropriate compromise solution in the new Treaty of the European Union.

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland emphasises that Poland's active presence in a strong and effective Union is in line with the Polish *raison d'État*.
