

RESOLUTION
OF THE SEJM OF THE REPUBLIC OF POLAND

of 20 March 2025

on the security of the Republic of Poland

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland, guided by concern over the security of the Republic of Poland, expresses its full support for the solutions included in the European Parliament resolution of 12 March 2025 on the white paper on the future of European defence. The Sejm of the Republic of Poland emphasises the necessity to increase the involvement and the role of European countries within the NATO defence structure.

Taking into account the aggressive policy of the Russian Federation, including the war against Ukraine and destabilising hybrid operations against many European countries, it is necessary to take coordinated actions aimed at strengthening the defence of the Republic of Poland as a country that takes on a special obligation to ensure the security of the eastern border of the European Union and the eastern flank of NATO.

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland considers the provision of the resolution concerning the Eastern Border Shield, which is regarded as the flagship project of the European Union in the field of security and defence, to be particularly important. This programme, that provides for the construction of military infrastructure, fortifications and deterrence systems on the eastern borders of the European Union, is a key element in ensuring the stability and security of this part of Europe. Its implementation should be treated as a priority at both the national and European level.

All necessary actions should be taken to secure full political and financial support for the Eastern Border Shield programme, to intensify cooperation with European and transatlantic partners in the field of security, and to promote European defence cooperation, including the development of common military capabilities and deterrence systems.

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland emphasizes that at a time of growing tensions in the world, Europe must take greater responsibility for its security, and that it is in our national interest to strengthen international cooperation in the field of common defence. Historical experience tells us to avoid to be alone in security matters. Our goal is therefore to strengthen NATO and to enhance effective defence cooperation between its member states. A real European cooperation in the area of defence is necessary to ensure the security of Poles and to strengthen the trust and ability to jointly defend partners on both sides of the Atlantic.

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland calls on all political forces in the Republic of Poland to be united, determined, to take joint actions for national security and to strengthen the capacity for common defence of European states.
