



## 11<sup>th</sup> sitting of the Sejm, 9–11 February 2016

### The Sejm passed the acts

- on the state's help in raising children;
- amending the Family and Guardianship Code;
- amending the act on court fees in civil cases;
- amending the act on the divisions of government administration and some related acts.

### The Sejm referred to committees

- Deputies' bill amending the Constitution of the Republic of Poland (the motion to reject the bill in the first reading was not accepted);
- Government's bill on the Bank Guarantee Fund, the system of deposit guarantees and forced restructuring;
- Government's bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure and some related acts (the motion to reject the bill in the first reading was not accepted).

### The Sejm adopted resolutions

- honouring the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the deportation of Poles to Kazakstan;
- on the 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the registration of the Independent Students' Association (Niezależne Zrzeszenie Studentów);
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

**The Sejm returned to a committee** the Deputies' draft resolution concerning the immigration policy of the Polish State at the European Union forum (the motion to reject the draft resolution was not accepted).

### The Sejm accepted

- Information of the Minister relevant for education and upbringing on the state of preparations of governing authorities to subject six-year-old children to schooling duty;
- Report of the Council of Ministers on the public aid provided to entrepreneurs in Poland in 2014, along with the Report on de minimis aid provided to entrepreneurs in Poland in 2014.

**The Sejm received the Government's current information** on the situation of health resorts.

**The Sejm received** the oath of Grażyna Maria Ancyparowicz and Eryk Mariusz Łon, appointed as members of the Monetary Policy Council at the 10<sup>th</sup> sitting of the Sejm.

**The Sejm did not appoint** Mateusz Szczurek as a member of the Monetary Policy Council.

**With a moment of silence, the Sejm honoured the memory of**

- Maria Stypułkowska-Chojecka, a.k.a. Kama, who died on 5 February 2016, soldier of the Home Army, liaison of Battalion "Parasol", participant to the execution of the death sentence on Franz Kutschera, known as the executioner of Warsaw;
- Colonel Ryszard Kukliński on the 12<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his death;
- Zygmunt Szendzielarz, a.k.a. Łupaszka, Polish Army and Home Army mayor, on the 65<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his death;
- victims of the deportation to Siberia on the 76<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first transportation.
