

28th sitting of the Sejm, 5–7 December 2012

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on farmers' social insurance premiums for 2012;
- amending the act on the National Criminal Register and some related acts;
- amending the act on supporting the family and the system of foster care;
- amending the Water Law and some related acts;
- amending the Aviation Law;
- amending the Environment Protection Act and the act on occupational and social rehabilitation and on the employment of disabled persons.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure, the Penal Code and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code;
- Deputies' bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure;
- Government bill amending the act on public offer and terms for introducing financial instruments into the organised turnover system and on public companies, as well as amending some related acts;
- Citizens' bill amending the act on the income of the units of local government;
- Government bill amending the act on public finance and the act on the goods and services tax.

THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bills: amending the act on the local government employees; amending the act on the local government employees, the commune government, district government and the voivodship government,
- Deputies' bills amending the Standing Orders of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland (*of prints no. 11 and 440*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the act on family benefits and some related acts (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on tonnage tax and some related acts (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on the goods and services tax and some related acts (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending particular acts as regards the realisation of the Budget Act (*The Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on population records and identification documents and some related acts (*Some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning the prevention of the social exclusion of the disabled persons;
- declaring 2013 the Year of Jan Czocharlski;

- declaring 2013 the Year of Julian Tuwim;
- declaring 2013 the Year of Witold Lutosławski;
- honouring the 100th anniversary of Jerzy Turowicz's birthday;
- concerning the 90th anniversary of the murder of President Gabriel Narutowicz.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION

of the Prime Minister on the state of negotiations of the legislation package related to the Common Agricultural Policy past 2013 in relation to the EU's new Financial Framework for the years 2014–2020 and on the methods of realisation of the resolution of the Sejm of 25 April 2012 on supporting the Government of the Republic of Poland and summoning the European Parliament to actively pursue the simplification of the Common Agricultural Policy, competitiveness and progress, as well as the introduction of equal and non-discriminating principles of the division of funds for direct farming subsidies between the Member States of the European Union, as well as on the approach to the issues related to agriculture and rural development adopted in the programme and legislative documents of the EU and the Government related to the financial perspective 2014–2020 as regards improving the quality of life in the rural areas (*The Marshal of the Sejm postponed to the next sitting of the Sejm the consideration of the motion to reject the information*).
