

32nd sitting of the Sejm, 23-25 JANUARY 2013

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on warranties and guarantees granted by the State Treasury and particular legal persons;
- amending the act on public offer and terms for introducing financial instruments into the organized turnover system and on public companies, as well as amending some related acts;
- amending the Bankruptcy and Remedial Law;
- on crop protection chemicals;
- amending the act on cleanliness and order maintenance within communes;
- amending the act on payments within direct aids systems;
- amending the act on spatial planning and order.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- commemorating the establishing of the Polski Theatre in Warsaw;
- amending the Standing Orders of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland;
- concerning the appointment and election of a personal composition of the Special Committee to examine particular bills regarding the Cooperative Law; The following Deputies were appointed members of the Committee: *Elżbieta Achinger (Civic Platform – PO), Romuald Ajchler (Democratic Left Alliance – SLD), Edmund Borawski (Polish People’s Party – PSL), Jerzy Borowczak (PO), Krzysztof Brejza (PO), Borys Budka (PO), Zofia Czernow (PO), Andrzej Dera (Law and Justice – PiS), Marek Gos (PSL), Witold Klepacz (Palikot’s Movement – RP), Brygida Kolenda-Łabuś (PO), Arkadiusz Litwiński (PO), Gabriela Masłowska (PiS), Antoni Mężydło (PO), Maria Nowak (PiS), Paweł Sajak (RP), Grzegorz Schreiber (PiS), Krystyna Sibińska (PO), Lidia Staroń (PO), Stefan Strzałkowski (PiS), Paweł Suski (PO), Andrzej Szlachta (PiS), Jerzy Szmít (PiS), Tomasz Szymański (PO), Łukasz Zbonikowski (PiS), Kosma Złotowski (PiS).*
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies’ bill on cooperatives;
- Deputies’ bill amending the act on housing cooperatives;

- Deputies’ bill on housing cooperatives;
- Deputies’ bill on the activity of the housing cooperatives;
(The motions to reject the above bills, submitted at the 31st sitting of the Sejm, were withdrawn by their sponsors.)
- Deputies’ bill amending the Penal Code and the Code of Penal Procedure;
- Senate’s bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure and the Petty Offences Procedure Code;
- Deputies’ bill amending the Code of Penal Procedure and the act on the system of common courts.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE’S RESOLUTION CONCERNING the Budget Act for 2013 (The Senate’s amendments were accepted).

THE SEJM ACCEPTED the „Information on the functioning of the Social Integration Centres and Clubs for the Sejm and the Senate of the Republic of Poland” submitted by the Prime Minister.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION on the so-called Energy Three-Pack consisting of the Energy Law, the Gas Law and the act on the renewable energy sources.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE SECOND READING the report of the Committee on the bill on retaining by the Polish State of the majority shareholding of the Lotos Group Joint Stock Company.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

THE SEJM DID NOT ACCEPT the Deputies’ motion for a vote of no confidence in the Minister of Health Bartosz Arłukowicz.
