

61st SITTING OF THE SEJM, 19–21 FEBRUARY 2014

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on the system of education;
- on indemnity compensation for incurred casualties and illnesses related to the service, on the European Citizens' Initiative';
- amending the act on court fees in civil cases;
- amending the Penal Code and some related acts;
- amending the Petty Offences Procedure Code;
- on village head fund;
- amending the act on agricultural chambers and some related acts;
- ratifying amendments to the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court drawn up in Rome on 17 July 1998, adopted during the Review Congress in Kampala (resolutions nos. 5 and 6) on 10 and 11 June 2010.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning participation of the Republic of Poland in the works of the European Union in the period between July and December 2013 – during Lithuanian Presidency of the Council of European Union (*In a resolution, the Sejm accepted the information of the Council of Ministers concerning participation of the Republic of Poland in the works of the EU in the period between July and December 2013, submitted at the 60th sitting*).
- honouring the memory of Maciej Rataj on 130th anniversary of his birth;
- commemorating colonel Ryszard Kukliński;
- concerning granting the consent of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland to bring Deputy Ryszard Zbrzyzny to criminal accountability (*The Sejm did not grant the consent to bring the Deputy to accountability*).

THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEES

- Deputies' bill amending the act on competition and consumer protection;
- Government bill amending the act on competition and consumer protection and the Code of Civil Procedure.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill amending the act on the National Court Register and some related acts;
- Government bill amending the Water Law and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill on metropolitan district;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on quartering of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Poland.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

the Senate's bill on anti-communist opposition activists and persons repressed for political reasons (*The vote on the motion to reject the bill was postponed to the next sitting*).

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

the Deputies' bill amending the Electoral Code.

THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- information of the Prime Minister on the situation in Ukraine;
- "Report on the realisation of the National Programme for the Counteraction of Cancerous Diseases in 2012," presented by the Minister of Health, as well as the Schedule for the realisation of tasks as regards the long-term National Programme of Counteraction of Cancerous Diseases in 2013 and the Directions for the realization of the Programme's Tasks in 2014 and 2015, adopted by the Council of Ministers.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED

- report on realisation of the National Development Strategy 2007–2015 in the years 2011 and 2012 (*The vote on the motion to reject the report was postponed to the next sitting*);
- document "State of road traffic safety and activities realised in that scope in 2012" presented by the Prime Minister (*The vote on the motion to reject the information was postponed to the next sitting*).
