

72nd SITTING OF THE SEJM, 22–25 JULY 2014

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on health care benefits financed out of public funds and some related acts;
- amending the act on the professions of a nurse and nurse-widwife and some related acts;
- amending the act on consultants in health care;
- amending the Public Procurement Law;
- amending the Code of Civil Procedure and the act on court fees in civil cases;
- amending the act on supporting the family and the system of foster care, and some related acts;
- on the special hydrocarbon tax;
- on energy characteristics of buildings;
- amending the act on social pension and the act on health care benefits financed out of public funds;
- amending the act on the goods and services tax and the Tax Ordinance;
- amending the act on public roads, the act on toll motorways and the National Road Fund, and the act on road transport;
- amending the Atomic Law;
- on founding the Polish Space Agency;
- ratifying the Agreement on privileges and immunities of the International Renewable Energy Agency drawn up in Abu Zabi on 13 January 2013.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning the report on the implementation of the Budget in the period between 1 January and 31 December 2013 and granting approval of the financial accounts submitted by the Council of Ministers;
- honouring the heroes of the Polish road to freedom;
- on the 70th anniversary of the outbreak of the Warsaw Uprising;
- honouring the 70th anniversary of the operation "The Gate of Dawn;"
- honouring the 150th anniversary of the death of Romuald Traugutt;
- honouring the 150th anniversary of the birth and 75th anniversary of the death of Roman Dmowski;
- honouring the memory of victims of the Augustów roundup of July 1945;
- concerning the appointment of the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection (*the Sejm appointed Wojciech Rafał Wiewiórowski for this position*);
- concerning election of the new personal composition of the European Union Affairs Committee;
- concerning granting the consent by the Sejm of the Republic of Poland to bring Deputy Tadeusz Iwiński to criminal accountability for his offence.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill on facilitating the performance of business activity;

- Government bill amending the Penal Code and some related acts;
- Senate's bill amending the Penal Code and some related acts;
- Senate's bill amending the Law on proceedings before administrative courts;

THE SEJM ACCEPTED

THE SEJM WAS PRESENTED WITH INFORMATION

- on the activity of the National Bank of Poland in 2013;
- on on relevant problems resulting from the activity and jurisprudence of the Constitutional Tribunal in 2013;
- of the Prosecutor General on recent activities conducted by the organs of the Prosecution Service against Deputy Jan Bury.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED the Deputies' draft resolution concerning the appointment of an investigative committee to examine circumstances of the origin of the bill liquidating the Military Information Services (WSI) and the verification of their personnel, of the origin and publishing of the "Report on activities on soldiers and employees of the Military

Information Services and the military organizational units realizing tasks in the scope of military intelligence and counterintelligence prior to entry into force of the act of 9 July 2003 on the Military Information Services in the scope specified in Article 67 para. 1 item 1–10 of the act of 9 June 2006 'Introductory provisions to the act on the Military Counterintelligence Service and the Military Intelligence Service and the act on the service of the officials of the Military Counterintelligence Service and the Military Intelligence Service,' as well as other activities transgressing the matters of the defence of the state and the security of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Poland," to examine the circumstances of the verification of the Military Information Services personnel by the Verification Committee in the period between 21 July 2006 and 30 June 2008 and the effects thereof, and to examine the reasons for the discontinuation of investigation ref. no. Ap V Ds. 49/09 conducted by the Appellate Public Prosecutor's Office in Warsaw in relation to effects of investigations conducted by the military public prosecu-

tion and the decisions of civil courts, in the aspect of the threat to security of the Republic of Poland (*the vote on the motion to reject the draft resolution was postponed to the next sitting of the Sejm*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED AND REFERRED TO THE COMMITTEE

the report on the motion of the Commander-in-Chief of the Police of 25 April 2014 concerning granting the consent by the Sejm to bring Deputy Wojciech Penkalski to criminal accountability for his offence.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION

concerning the income conditions of persons living off retirement pay and social benefits.
