

## 73<sup>rd</sup> SITTING OF THE SEJM, 27–29 AUGUST 2014

### THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the act on health care benefits financed out of public funds and some related acts;
- amending the act on professional and social rehabilitation and on employment of persons with disabilities and some related acts;
- amending the Code of Penal Procedure and the act which itself amended the Code of Penal Procedure and some related acts;
- ratifying the Arms Trade Treaty drawn up in New York on 2 April 2013.

### THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- amending the resolution concerning the appointment and election of the personal composition of the Special Committee to examine particular bills in the scope of the cooperative law;
- concerning granting the consent by the Sejm of the Republic of Poland to bring Deputy Krzysztof Wawrzyniec Borkowski to criminal accountability (*the Sejm did not grant its consent*);
- concerning granting the consent by the Sejm of the Republic of Poland to bring Deputy Beata Kempa to civil accountability (*the Sejm did not grant its consent*).

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the Public Procurement Law (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Code of Civil Procedure and the act on court fees in civil cases (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on public roads, the act on toll motorways and the National Road Fund and the act on road transport (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on batteries and accumulators and some related acts (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Bankruptcy and Remedial Law, the act on the National Court Register and the act on court fees in civil cases (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on the corporate income tax, the act on the personal income tax and some related acts (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- on energy characteristics of buildings (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*).

**THE SEJM RETURNED TO A COMMITTEE** the Government bill amending the act on genetically modified organisms and some related acts.

### THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill on protection and help for the victim and the witness;
- President of the Republic's bill amending the act on the universal duty to defend the Republic of Poland and some related acts;
- Government bill amending the act on the commune government and some related acts;
- Government bill amending the Code of Civil Procedure and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code.

**THE SEJM REFERRED TO A COMMITTEE** the Deputies' draft resolution concerning the appointment of an investigative committee to examine circumstances of the origin of the bill liquidating the Military Information Services (WSI) and the verification of their personnel, of the origin and publishing of the "Report on activities on soldiers and employees of the Military Information Services and the military organizational units realizing tasks in the scope of military intelligence and counterintelligence prior to entry into force of the act of 9 July 2003 on the Military Information Services in the scope specified in Article 67 para. 1 item 1–10 of the act of 9 June 2006 'Introductory provisions to the act on the Military Counterintelligence Service and the Military Intelligence Service and the act on the service of the officials of the Military Counterintelligence Service and the Military Intelligence Service,' as well as other activities transgressing the matters of the defence of the state and the security of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Poland," to examine the circumstances of the verification of the Military Information Services personnel by the Verification Committee in the period between 21 July 2006 and 30 June 2008 and the effects thereof, and to examine the reasons for the discontinuation of investigation ref. no. Ap V Ds. 49/09 conducted by the Appellate Public Prosecutor's Office in Warsaw in relation to effects of investigations conducted by the military public prosecution and the decisions of civil courts, in the aspect of the threat to security of the Republic of Poland.

### THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- information of the Prime Minister on activities of the Government in the next months;
- the report of the Minister of Sport and Tourism on realization of EURO 2012 undertakings and tasks realised as regards Poland's preparation for the European Football Championship UEFA EURO 2012 Final Tournament (January–December 2012) and the report of the Minister of Sport and Tourism on realization of EURO 2012 undertakings (January–December 2013);
- document "The state of safety of the road traffic and activities realised in this scope in 2013" submitted by the Prime Minister.

### THE SEJM CONSIDERED

- report of the Minister of the Interior on the realisation in 2013 of the act of 24 March 1920 on purchasing real estate property by foreigners (*the motion to reject the report shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm*);
- report of the Minister of Infrastructure and Development on the realisation of tasks resulting from the act of 28 March 2003 on the establishment of the long-term "Seashore protection programme" in 2013 and the task schedule for 2014 (*the motion to reject the report shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

**THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE SECOND READING** the Citizens' bill amending the act on the system of education and the act which itself amended the act on the system of education and some related acts.

**THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION** concerning the already taken the planned actions of the Government as regards the difficult situation of Polish fruit and vegetable producers and exporters past the imposition of an embargo by the Russian Federation.
