

74th SITTING OF THE SEJM, 10–12 SEPTEMBER 2014

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- on the reverse mortgage loan;
- amending the act on toll motorways and the National Road Fund, the act on the Railway Fund and the act on the excise duty;
- ratifying the Council of Europe Convention on Cybercrime, drawn up in Budapest on 23 November 2001;
- ratifying the Additional Protocol to the Convention on Cybercrime, concerning the criminalisation of acts of a racist and xenophobic nature committed through computer systems, drawn up in Strasbourg on 28 January 2003.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

- Deputies' bill amending the act on the personal income tax, the act on the freedom of business activity and the act on the safety of food and nourishment;
- Deputies' bill amending the act on the personal income tax and some related acts;
- Government bill amending the Law on the system of common courts and some related acts;
- Government bill amending the Law on the system of military courts;
- Government bill amending the Civil Code, the Code of Civil Procedure and some related acts.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

- Citizens' bill amending the act of 6 June 1997 – the Penal Code;
- Deputies' bill amending the Labour Code and some related acts.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning the Information for the Sejm and the Senate on the participation of the Republic of Poland in the works of the European Union in the period between January and June 2014 (Greek Presidency of the Council of the European Union);
- on the 25th anniversary of the appointment of the government of Tadeusz Mazowiecki;
- honouring the memory of August Cieszkowski on the 200th anniversary of his birth;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- the report of the Minister of the Interior on the realisation in 2013 of the act of 24 March 1920 on purchasing real estate property by foreigners;
- the information of the Minister of Infrastructure and Development on the realisation of tasks resulting from the act of 28 March 2003 establishing a long-term Seashore Protection Programme in 2013 and the schedule of tasks for 2014.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED the report on the realisation of the National Cancerous Disease Counteraction Programme in 2013 presented by the Minister of Health, and the schedule of tasks being realised as regards the long-term National Cancerous Disease Counteraction Programme in 2014 and 2015 adopted by the Council of Ministers (*the motion to reject the report shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting*).

THE SEJM WAS PRESENTED WITH THE CURRENT INFORMATION on the state of safety on the Polish roads.
