

80th SITTING OF THE SEJM, 26–28 NOVEMBER 2014

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending specific acts due to the realization of the Budget Act;
- on bonds;
- amending the act on payment services;
- amending the Code of Civil Procedure and some related acts;
- amending the Commercial Companies Code and some related acts;
- amending the act on genetically modified organisms and some related acts;
- amending the act on professional and social rehabilitation and on employment of persons with disabilities;
- amending the act on the Customs Service, the act on fiscal offices and chambers and some related acts;
- amending the act on special economic zones and some related acts;
- amending the act on the excise duty;
- ratifying the Association Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community and their Member States, of the one part, and Ukraine, of the other part, drawn up in Brussels on 21 March 2014 and 27 June 2014.

THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- commemorating the 75th anniversary of the displacement of the civil population of Gdynia;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the act on the safety of food and nourishment;
- amending the act on cleanliness and order maintenance within communes and some related acts;
- on medical boards subjected to the minister relevant for the interior;
- Law on vital records;
- on protection and help for the victim and the witness;
- amending the act on plant protection chemicals;
- annulling the act establishing the long-term "Programme for the Oder – 2006;"
- amending the act on the National Court Register and some related acts.

THE SEJM RETURNED TO A COMMITTEE the Committee draft resolution amending the Standing Orders of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- Government bill – Large Family Charter;
- Committee bill amending the act on the safety of mass events and some related acts;
- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Execution Code;
- Senate's bill amending the Penal Execution Code.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

- Government bill on sea fishing;
- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code and the Code of Petty Offences.

(The motions to reject the bills shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm.)

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE SECOND READING the Deputies' bill amending the act on the commune guard and the Law on the road traffic.

THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING the Deputies' bill to amend the act on the personal income tax *(the motion to reject the bill was submitted at the 79th sitting of the Sejm).*

THE SEJM ACCEPTED the report on the results of an audit concerning safety in road traffic submitted by the President of the Supreme Audit Office.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION concerning the new EU 2030 framework for climate and energy policy.

THE SEJM DID NOT COMPLETE the additional election of a member of the Tribunal of State *(163 Deputies voted for the candidature of Piotr Pszczółkowski, submitted by members of Law and Justice Parliamentary Club, 215 voted against, 33 withheld their votes.)*

Robert Tomasz Maciaszek took the Deputies' oath.
