

## 86<sup>TH</sup> SITTING OF THE SEJM, 4–6 FEBRUARY 2015

### THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the Penal Code and some related acts;
- on payments within the direct support systems;
- amending the Civil Code and some related acts;
- amending the Construction Law and some related acts;
- amending the act on professional and social rehabilitation and on the employment of persons with disabilities;
- amending the act on the national archive resources and archives;
- amending the Penal Execution Code;
- amending the Law on vital records;
- ratifying the Council of Europe Convention on preventing and combating violence against women and domestic violence, drawn up in Istanbul on 11 May 2011;
- ratifying the Association Agreement between the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community and their Member States, of the one part, and Georgia, of the other part, drawn up in Brussels on 27 June 2014.

### THE SEJM ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS

- concerning participation of the Republic of Poland in the works of the European Union in the period between July and December 2014 (Italian Presidency of the Council of the European Union);
- honouring professor Halina Szwarc in relations to the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of establishing the first University of the Third Age in Poland;
- commemorating the 95<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Poland's Wedding to the Sea;
- concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

### THE SEJM RETURNED TO COMMITTEES

- President of the Republic's bill amending the Electoral Code;

- Deputies' bill amending the Electoral Code;
- Government bill on the Mutual Aid Fund in Stabilization of Farm Income;
- Government bill amending the act on the goods and services tax and the Public Procurement Law;
- Senate's bill amending the act on the state compensation for the victims of particular crimes, as well as the Code of Civil Procedure.

### THE SEJM REJECTED IN THE FIRST READING

the Deputies' bill amending the act on the personal income tax.

### THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- report of the Council of Ministers on the realization of the National Domestic Violence Counteraction Programme in the period between 1 January 2013 and 31 December 2013;
- reports of the Council of Ministers on the realization of the act of 26 October 1982 on upbringing in sobriety and alcoholism prevention in the period between 1 January 2011 and 31 December 2011 and in the period between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2012.

**THE SEJM ACCEPTED THE CURRENT INFORMATION** concerning the Government's position as regards the organization of the celebration of the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of World War II in Westerplatte, as proposed by President of the Republic of Poland Bronisław Komorowski, and their influence of Polish-Russian relations.

**THE SEJM DID NOT ELECT** Piotr Pszczółkowski the member of the Tribunal of State.
