

91ST SITTING OF THE SEJM, 22–24 APRIL 2015

THE SEJM PASSED THE ACTS

- amending the Law on higher education and the act on the personal income tax;
- amending the act on farmland and livestock insurance;
- amending the act on agricultural chambers and some related acts;
- amending the act on payments within direct aid systems;
- mending the Energy Law;
- amending the act on the recycling of vehicles withdrawn from exploitation and some related acts;
- amending the act on district government;
- amending the act on therapeutic activity;
- establishing the National Victory Day.

THE SEJM REFERRED TO COMMITTEES

- President of the Republic's bill amending particular acts due to supporting innovation;
- President of the Republic's bill amending the Labour Code and some related acts;
- Government bill amending the Labour Code and some related acts;
- Government bill on tax administration;
- Government draft Consular Law.

THE SEJM CONSIDERED IN THE FIRST READING

- Citizens' bill amending the Electoral Code and some related acts (*the motion to reject the bill in the first reading shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm*);

- Deputies' bill amending the Penal Code (*the motion to reject the bill in the first reading shall be subject to a vote at the next sitting of the Sejm*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ACT amending particular acts due to the strengthening of the instruments of landscape protection (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM ACCEPTED the report of the Minister of Foreign Affairs on the goals of Polish foreign policy in 2015 (*for rejecting the report presented by Minister Grzegorz Schetyna there voted 191 Deputies, 244 voted against rejecting it and 3 Deputies withheld their votes*).

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE CURRENT INFORMATION concerning preparations for the presidential elections in 2015.

THE SEJM ADOPTED THE RESOLUTION concerning changes within personal composition of the Sejm committees.

BEFORE THE SEJM, Edyta Bielak-Jomaa took the oath of the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection.

WITH A MOMENT OF SILENCE, THE SEJM HONOURED the memory of **Barbara Blida**, Deputy to the Sejm of the 10th, 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th term, Minister of Spatial Planning and Construction in the years 1993–1996, on the 8th anniversary of her tragic death.
