

102ND SITTING OF THE SEJM, 8–9 OCTOBER 2015

THE SEJM CONSIDERED THE SENATE'S RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE ACTS

- amending the Banking Law and some related acts (*of prints no. 1441, 3425, 3426; the Senate's amendment was rejected*);
- amending the act on the personal income tax, the act on the corporate income tax and some related acts (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Banking Law and some related acts (*of print no. 3434; the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- on supporting housing credit beneficiaries in a difficult financial situation (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- on implementation of the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Poland and the Government of the United States of America to Improve International Tax Compliance and to Implement FATCA (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on payment due dates in commerce transactions, the Civil Code and some related acts (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- on revitalisation (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Road Traffic Law (*the Senate's motion to reject the act was accepted*);
- on metropolitan unions (*some of the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- on biocide products (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the Law on the System of Common Courts (*the Senate's motion to reject the act was not accepted*);
- amending the Penal Code and some related acts (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on forests (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);
- amending the act on disclosing information on the environment and its protection, public participation in the environment protection and environmental im-

pact assessments, as well as amending some related acts (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*);

- amending the act on the information system in health care and some related acts (*the Senate's amendments were accepted*).

THE SEJM ACCEPTED

- "Information of the Government of the Republic of Poland on activities undertaken in 2014 for the purpose of realisation of provisions of the act of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland of 1 August 1997 – The Disabled Persons Charter" (*the Sejm did not accept the motion to reject the information*);
- "Report on the realisation of the 'National Programme for the Counteraction of Cancerous Diseases' in 2014", presented by the Minister of Health, as well as the schedule for the realisation of tasks as regards the long-term National Programme of Counteraction of Cancerous Diseases in 2014 and 2015 (*the Sejm did not accept the motion to reject the report*);
- document "State of road traffic safety and activities realised in that scope in 2014" submitted by the Prime Minister (*the Sejm did not accept the motion to reject the document*);
- report on the realization of tasks resulting from the long-term "Programme for the Oder – 2006" in 2014, submitted by the Council of Ministers;
- report on the realization of the "Swinna Poręba water reservoir construction programme for 2006–2015" in 2014, submitted by the Minister of Environment (*the Sejm did not accept the motion to reject the report*).

THE SEJM HEARD THE GOVERNMENT'S CURRENT INFORMATION

concerning Poland's admittance of persons relocated and displaced due to the increasing immigrant inflow from Syria and Eritrea.
