

RESOLUTION  
OF THE SEJM OF THE REPUBLIC OF POLAND

of 2 December 2016

**on the proposal to establish the European Union corrective allocation mechanism for  
refugees and financial solidarity mechanism**

In response to the presented proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council, amending the Regulation of the European Parliament and Council on establishing the criteria and mechanisms for determining the Member State responsible for examining an application for international protection lodged in one of the Member States by a third-country national or a stateless person (recast) (COM (2016) 270 final), the Sejm of the Republic of Poland hereby resolves as follows:

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland firmly stands by the position expressed in its resolution of 1 April 2016 on the Polish immigration policy, wherein its disapproval of any attempts to establish permanent mechanisms for allocation of refugees or migrants was articulated.

Along the same lines, the Sejm of the Republic of Poland strongly opposes the proposal to establish a corrective allocation mechanism under the aforementioned proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council, indicating that introducing such a system of migrants redistribution could result in intensifying the illegal immigration flows towards the territory of the European Union.

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland also believes that by no means can the proposal to establish a financial solidarity mechanism be accepted in the case when a state suspends its involvement in the allocation system.

At the same time, the Sejm of the Republic of Poland emphasises that the Republic of Poland does not evade its commitment to contribute to solving the migration crisis, especially its financial commitment to support third countries in order to prevent the causes of the migration crisis, and to protect the European Union's external borders.

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland considers that adopting the proposed Regulation would constitute a violation of the powers vested in the Member States under the treaties in

the scope of social security system, home security policy and integration policy.
