

RESOLUTION
OF THE SEJM OF THE REPUBLIC OF POLAND

of 20 May 2016

**on the protection of the sovereignty of the Republic
of Poland and the rights of its citizens**

According to the Constitution, the Republic of Poland is a sovereign, democratic state ruled by law. Recently, the sovereignty of our country is being breached, which at the same time undermines democracy, legal system and social harmony in Poland.

The excuse to undertake such actions is the political dispute concerning the Constitutional Tribunal. The Sejm of the Republic of Poland claims that civil rights and liberties are not at risk in our country. New legal solutions concerning the Constitutional Tribunal may be established only as a result of a dialogue held in the Sejm of the Republic of Poland. The parliamentary majority is ready to seek such a compromise in cooperation with the opposition parties.

EU institutions are also attempting to impose a decision on Poland concerning the immigrants who have arrived in Europe. The proposed decisions to solve this problem have no legal basis in the EU law, breach the sovereignty of our country, European values and the principle of subsidiarity of the European Union. They also pose risks to the social order in Poland, the safety of its citizens and the civilisation heritage, as well as the national identity.

The Sejm of the Republic of Poland calls on the government to object to any actions threatening the sovereignty of the country and states that the government is responsible for the protection of the national interest and the constitutional order of the Republic of Poland.
